If you drive, plan to use Lots A, B, or C, located on Ohio Drive between and flanking the spans of the 14th Street Bridges. The lots are up to a half-mile walk from the north steps of the Memorial facing the Tidal Basin, where the ceremony will take place.

The Halifax Resolves was a name later given to the resolution adopted by North Carolina on 12 April 1776. Adopting the resolution was the first official action in the

American Colonies calling for independence from Great Britain during the American Revolution. The Halifax Resolves helped pave the way for the presentation of the United States Declaration of Independence to Congress less than three months later.
