Details: The Battle of Brooklyn (also called the Battle of Long Island) was fought on August 27, 1776 and is considered one of America's greatest losses during our war for independence. The carnage all happened one summer night: The British, who had amassed a large number of troops on Staten Island, stealthily attacked George Washington and his Continental Army at their camp in Brooklyn. Washington was greatly outnumbered and realized the only way to save his army was to flee to Manhattan. While the rest of the troops escaped Brooklyn Heights across the river, Washington sent 400 troops from Baltimore, known as the Maryland 400, on a suicide mission: to distract the British and buy the rest of the troops time. The battle was fought near the present-day site of the Old Stone House. (The one standing in Park Slope today is a 1933 re-creation of the original.)

A large number of the 1st Maryland Regiment were killed, but their sacrifice enabled the Continental Army to escape.

Details: Lt. George Kilgour was a member of the Loudoun County Militia. He also provided supplies during the Revolutionary War. He was a mill operator and owned the land at the intersection of Rt 28 and Nokes Blvd; the land on which the Kilgour/Hummer Cemetery was located. The cemetery operated from 1770 to 1884 but was declared abandoned in 1962. Development in the area caused VDOT to move the graves to the present location. Of the 47 remains moved, only those of Lt. George Kilgour and his wife, Martina Bailey, are known. Registration
