Details: During a fireside chat between brothers Richard Henry Lee and Francis Lightfoot Lee, they will discuss the origins of the seeds of rebellion planted at the conclusion of the French and Indian War in 1763. At the conclusion of the lengthy and costly war, Britain was under a massive debt load and had to find relief. Several egregious acts ensued, including the 1765 Stamp Act, taxation without representation, and other taxes were raised to defray the debt and interest. The responses from the Colonists, including the 1766 Leedstown Resolutions, were just the tip of the iceberg. 

WREATHS: If you are riding the bus from Berry Hill to The Prizery, the bus will transport the wreaths in their luggage hold. When the bus arrives at The Prizery, JROTC volunteer will place the wreaths wherever weather permits.

If you are driving to The Prizery, bring the wreaths to the front door and the JROTC will place wreaths weather permitting.

In either both case, individuals will retrieve their wreaths at the close of the event (location determined by weather).

<u>Background</u>: Following an American victory at the Battle of Cowpens in South Carolina in January 1781, General Nathanael Greene's southern army outran British forces under Lord Cornwallis as both armies raced northward across the Carolinas. In what became known as the Race to the Dan, a few weeks later, on February 14, 1781, it became "The Crossing" when Greene's army crossed the Dan River to safety near South Boston. The Crossing of the Dan became a turning point in the American Revolution, precipitating events that led to the British surrender at Yorktown.

Location: Commences at the Prizery parking lot, 700 Bruce St., South Boston, VA. **Details:** <u>Guard muster immediately after the indoor ceremony in the Prizery parking lot and fall in behind the Halifax JROTC Color Guard (est. 11:15 am).</u> The JROTC CG will carry the US and VA Flags: and the SAR Honor Guard will carry all other flags (i.e., other State, Society, and Chapter flags). On signal, the formation will march to the Dan River for the Wreath Presentation Ceremony. <u>The length of march is approximately 500 yards</u>. The 7th VA Regt will provide musket volleys. On completion, meet at the Prizery for lunch and a brief awards presentation ceremony.

<u>Note:</u> if the Dan River is at flood stage on Saturday, the alternative wreath-presentation site will be at Constitution Square, across the street from the Prizery. The Halifax JROTC will serve as Color Guard at Constitution Square, and a VASSAR Honor Guard will carry Society flags.

February 10th, Friday (5:00 pm) – 242nd Commemoration of the Banister River Crossing Event

Event Level: Chapter

Details: Color Guard muster no later than 4:30 pm at the Courthouse.

The Race to the Dan River did not end General Greene's Southern Army's retreat from General Cornwallis' British Army after crossing the Dan River on February 14, 1781. That river was only passable by boat at the time but could have gone down quickly, allowing a continued pursuit by the British. Although Greene was successful in his objective, he was concerned enough to prepare for continuing the retreat by preparing another crossing of the Staunton River at Cole's Ferry. While some of Greene's troops stayed on the north bank of the Dan for surveillance, the main army moved north, crossing the Banister River at Cowford, near this site, onto the old Halifax Court House at Crystal Hill some five or six miles north of the Banister. The Dan River Chapter is working with the Town of Halifax to organize this event, which may include a reenactment and serving of Brunswick Stew!
