Details: During a fireside chat between brothers Richard Henry Lee and Francis Lightfoot Lee, they will discuss the origins of the seeds of rebellion planted after the French and Indian War in 1763. After the lengthy and costly war, Britain was under a massive debt load and had to find relief. Several egregious acts ensued, including the 1765 Stamp Act, taxation without representation, and other taxes being raised to defray the debt and interest. The responses from the Colonists, including the 1766 Leedstown Resolutions, were just the tip of the iceberg. The spiral of discontent had begun, and a flame had touched down on the long fuse to the biggest powder keg of all that would ignite the American Revolutionary War. Details: Following an American victory at the Battle of Cowpens in South Carolina in January 1781, General Nathanael Greene's southern army outran British forces under Lord Cornwallis as both armies raced northward across the Carolinas. What became known as the Race to the Dan a few weeks later, on February 14, 1781, became "The Crossing" when Greene's army crossed the Dan River to safety near South Boston. The Crossing of the Dan became a turning point in the American Revolution, precipitating events that led to the British surrender at Yorktown. Details: After a program at the church, the color guard will march to the Halifax War Memorial. The Race to the Dan River did not end General Greene's Southern Army's retreat from General Cornwallis' British Army after crossing the Dan River on February 14, 1781. That river was only passable by boat at the time but could have gone down quickly, allowing a continued pursuit by the British. Although Greene was successful in his objective, he was concerned enough to prepare for continuing the retreat by preparing another crossing of the Staunton River at Cole's Ferry. While some of Greene's troops stayed on the north bank of the Dan for surveillance, the main army moved north, crossing the Banister River at Cowford, near this site, onto the old Halifax Court House at Crystal Hill some five or six miles north of the Banister. Captain Slaughter was a Culpeper Minute Man who answered Patrick Henry's call to march on Williamsburg, served under Colonel Daniel Morgan, wintered at Valley Forge, and fought in the major battles of the war. Sergeant Vaughn served in the Virginia State Line and fulfilled a three-year term of service in the American Revolution.

Parking details: Enter from Hospital Street. The gate and the roads are narrow. The ceremony takes place at the SAR Patriots Monument located toward the back of the cemetery, straight down the entrance road. Park on the side of the cemetery roads, pulling to the right to allow traffic to pass your vehicle. Do not park beyond the monument to prevent vehicles from appearing in event photography.
