INFORMATION: March 29th, 2024, Friday – National Vietnam Veterans Day

Event Level: National

On March 29, 1973, U.S. President Richard Nixon officially withdrew the American combat forces from Vietnam. A year later, the first Vietnam Veterans Day was held. Vietnam Veterans Day commemorates the hardships suffered and sacrifices made by nine million Americans during the Vietnam War. However, the holiday honors those who served in that conflict and their families who supported them before and after the war. U.S. President Donald Trump formally signed the Vietnam War Veterans Recognition Act of 2017 as a law designated for the National Vietnam Veterans Day celebration on March 29 each year.

March 15th, 2024, Friday (11:00 am) – Commemoration of the Battle of Guilford Courthouse, Greensboro, NC

Details: The battle of Guilford Courthouse in North Carolina on March 15, 1781, proved pivotal to the American victory in the American Revolutionary War (1775-83). Although British troops under Lieutenant General Charles Cornwallis (1738-1805) scored a tactical victory at Guilford Courthouse over American forces under Major General Nathanael Greene (1742-86), the British suffered significant troop losses during the battle. Afterward, Cornwallis abandoned his campaign for the Carolinas and took his army into Virginia instead. In October of that year, he surrendered to General George Washington (1732-99) following the Battle of Yorktown, the last major land battle of the war.

Details: Colonel William Grayson first served as an aide to General George Washington during the Revolution, then formed an additional Continental Regiment to serve under the General throughout the remainder of the war. After the Revolution, Grayson was elected as one of the first senators from Virginia but died in office in 1790.
