All participants and attendees who don't have access to the installation <u>must</u> complete and return the BASE ACCESS PASS REGISTRATION form (Click here: <u>Access Form</u>).

The Battle of the Chesapeake, also known as the Battle of the Virginia Capes or simply the Battle of the Capes, was a crucial naval battle in the American Revolutionary War that took place near the mouth of the Chesapeake Bay on September 5, 1781. The combatants were a British fleet led by Rear Admiral Sir Thomas Graves and a French fleet led by Rear Admiral Francois Joseph Paul, the Comte de Grasse. The battle strategically prevented the Royal Navy from reinforcing or evacuating the besieged forces of Lieutenant General Lord Cornwallis at Yorktown, Virginia. The French achieved control of the sea lanes against the British and provided the Franco-American army with siege artillery and French reinforcements. These proved decisive in the Siege of Yorktown, effectively securing independence for the Thirteen Colonies. The guest speaker is **Rear Admiral Samuel Cox USN (ret.)**, Director, Naval History and Heritage Command. The senior French Navy representative will be **Rear Admiral Frederic de Rupilly**, J5 Plans, Joint Force Command, Norfolk. **The Hon. Bobby Dyer**, Mayor of Virginia Beach, will also attend.

Note: Thomson and Melhuish have the Base Commander's permission to bring two muskets and two swords for the Color Guard. No other VASSAR owned weapons will be permitted on the Base. Some pop-up shelters will be provided.

Details: The Gathering is in honor of the Overmountain Men and their victory over loyalist forces at the Battle of Kings Mountain.

On September 25 1780, a force of over 900 Patriots met at Fort Watauga near the Sycamore Shoals of the Watauga River to organize an expedition to cross the mountains to meet British Army Major Patrick Ferguson and his 1,100 Carolina Loyalists at Kings Mountain. The 243rd anniversary of the Gathering at Sycamore Shoals will be celebrated with a memorial service and a ceremonial wreath laying.
