All requests must be submitted via a Virginia Society SAR Chapter. Funds may be allocated only for the purposes described in the Knight-Patty Memorial Trust whose purposes and objectives are declared to be patriotic, historical, educational and charitable and shall include those intended or designed to perpetuate the memory of the men who achieved the independence of the United States of America, especially during the period of the years 1775-1783; to inspire their descendants and the community at large with a more profound reverence for the principles of the government founded by our forefathers; to encourage historical research relative to the American revolution; to acquire and preserve the records of the individual services of the patriots of that war, as well as the documents, relics and landmarks; to mark the scenes of the American Revolution by appropriate memorials; and such other purposes and objects that are in keeping with the preservation of Americanism as truly contained in the Constitution of the United States of America and as espoused by the Virginia Society, Sons of the American Revolution.

Appropriate Knight-Patty Memorial Trust Fund requests include projects whose purposes:

- Perpetuate the memory of the men who achieved the independence of the United States of America, especially during 1775 to 1783.
- Inspire their descendants and the community at large with a more profound reverence for the principles of the government founded by our forefathers.
- Encourage historical research relative to the American Revolution.
- Acquire and preserve individual service records, document, relics and landmarks.
- Mark the scenes of the American Revolution by appropriate memorials.
- Accomplish other such purposes and objects that are in keeping with the preservation of Americanism and truly contained in the U.S. Constitution and as espoused by the Virginia Society.

Additionally, sponsoring Virginia Society SAR Chapters are encouraged to not rely entirely on the Knight-Patty Memorial Trust Fund for project resourcing and consider how they will incorporate appropriate acknowledgment of the Virginia Society Sons of the American Revolution's financial support into their project.
